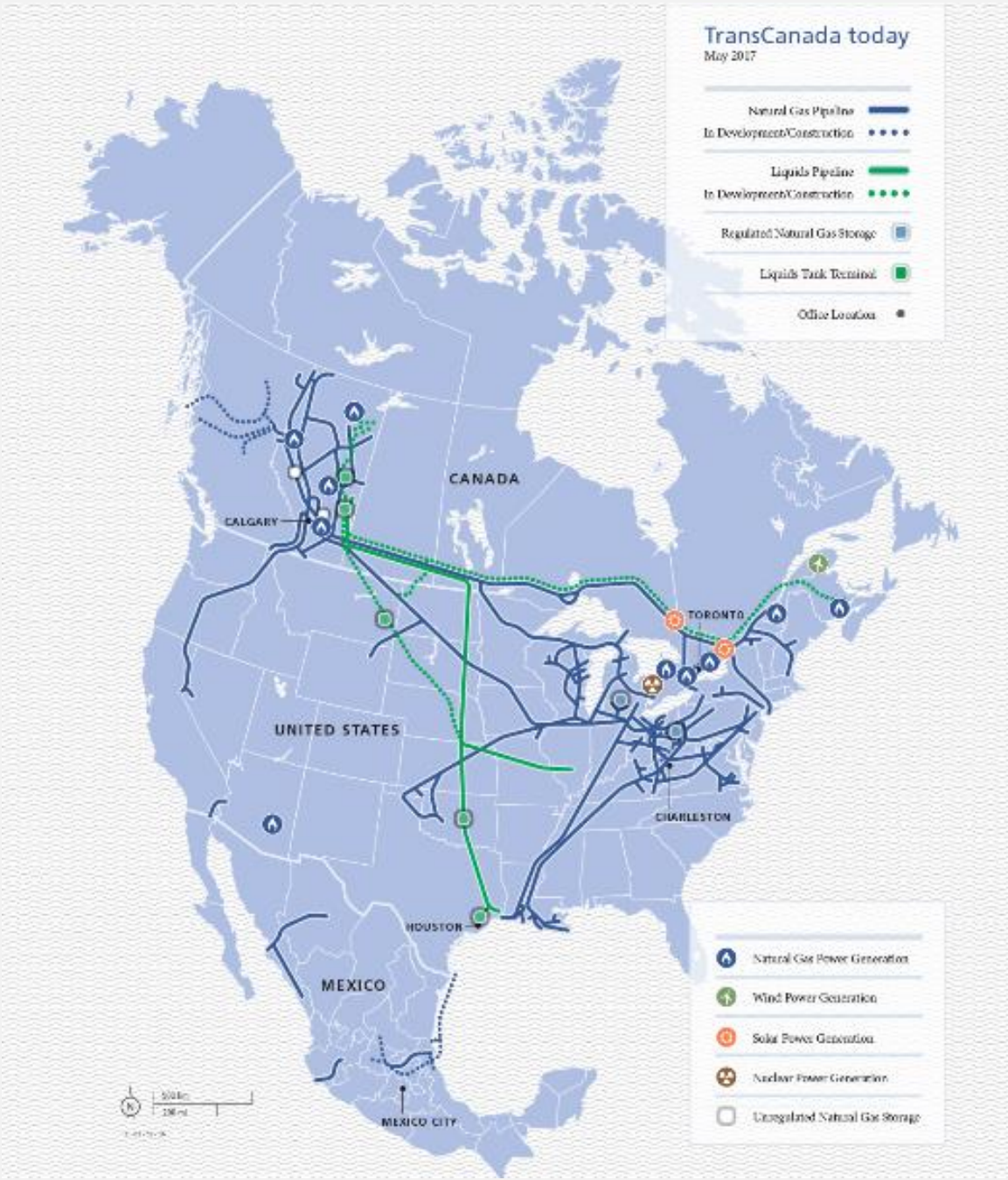

TransCanada Overview



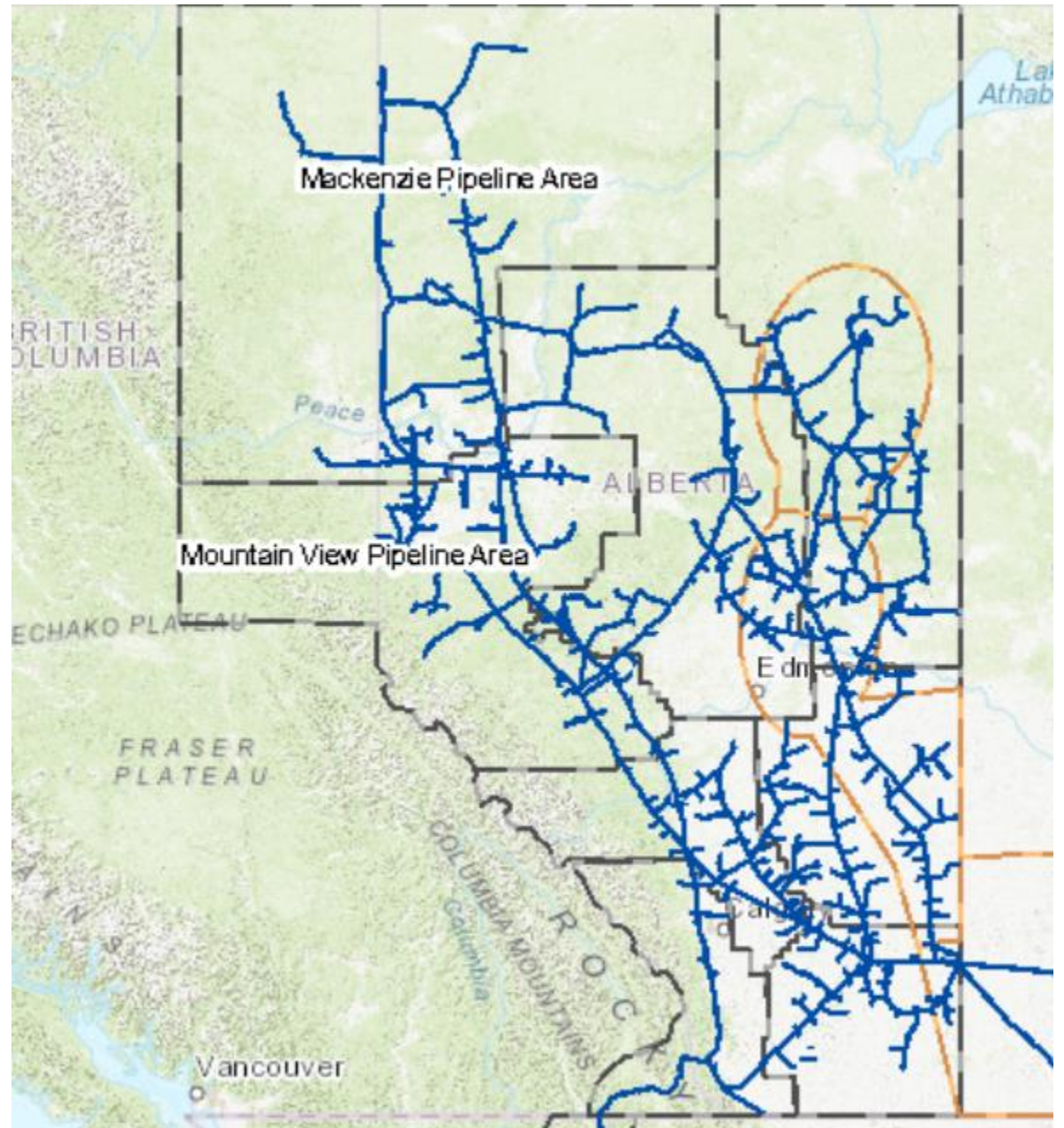
- One of the three largest pipeline companies in N. America

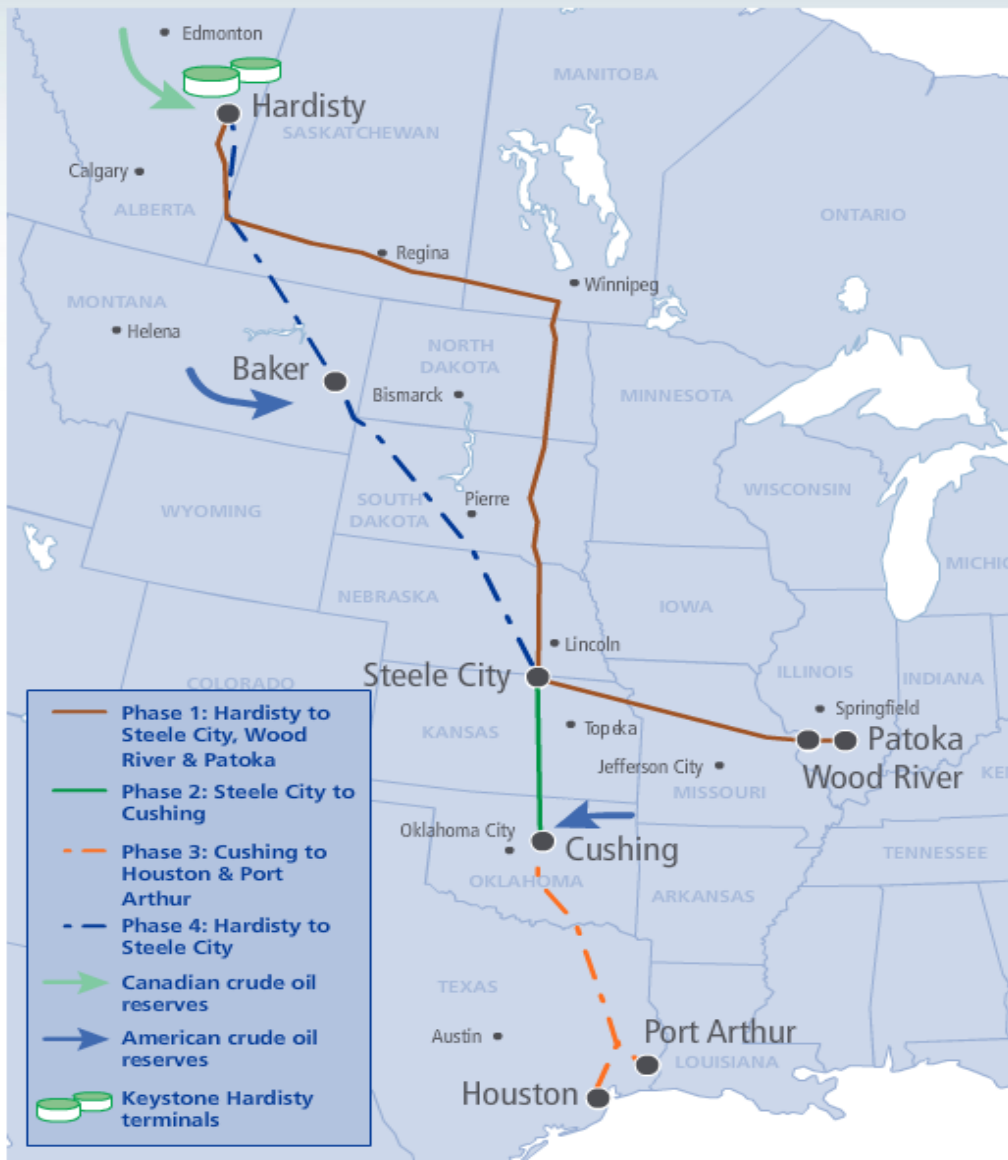
